PRINCIPLE - A Universal, Non-optional Cause and Effect Relationship

Giver – (Designed to impart, release, give generationally)

The redemptive gift of Giver is the fifth of the redemptive gifts: Prophet (principle of design), Servant (principle of authority), Teacher (principle of responsibility), Exhorter (principle of sowing & reaping), Giver (principle of stewardship), Ruler (principle of freedom), and Mercy (principle of fulfillment).

The redemptive gift of Giver parallels the principle of stewardship. To understand the principle of stewardship, it is imperative to remember that it builds upon the first four principles of design, authority, responsibility, and sowing & reaping. Let's take a look:

- Prophet Principle of Design: The prophet portion of your spirit's purpose is to discover principles that can be assembled to solve problems.
- 2) Servant Principle of Authority: The servant portion of your spirit's purpose is to use God's principles to generate more godly authority here on earth.
- 3) **Teacher Principle of Responsibility**: The teacher portion's purpose is to use God's principles to walk in truth and solve hard problems that surround him/her.
- 4) **Exhorter Principle of Sowing & Reaping**: The exhorter portion's purpose is to use principles to produce long-term life-giving changes.

How is Stewardship defined? Stewardship is defined as fulfilling an agenda belonging to someone else with resources belonging to someone else.

The call is:

 To effectively use the principles that produce life-giving changes generational, not for personal gain or for this generation. Think about what type of legacy you want to leave for the next generation.

 To be good stewards, to be productive, to cause measurable change in the Kingdom of Yah, and to give an account to Yahweh on what we do with the resources He has provided us.

The demonic stronghold of the redemptive gift of Giver is <u>ownership</u> which breeds the false identity mindset:

• "I am legitimate when people need me. I can provide the resources for others to possess their birthright." The truth is God loves you even when you are needy.

Walking in this false identity can place the Giver in unfortunate circumstances in life where they can't obtain enough assets or accrue wealth to leverage change. It can open the door for the Strongmen of Whoredoms, Jealousy, Bondage and others to set up house. Fruits of these roots are:

- **Whoredoms** Love of money, worldliness, excessive appetite, idolatry, chronic dissatisfaction, unfaithfulness, spirit, soul, or body prostitution/fornication.
- Jealousy Extreme competition, anger-rage, cruelty, strife, contention, envy, cause divisions, jealousy, murder.
- **Bondage** Fears, addictions (drugs, alcohol, cigarette, food, etc), compulsive sin, fear of death, servant of corruption, captivity to Satan.

Ownership implies a great deal of control that we are not necessarily to have. In Old Testament days, the people knew that they were to pay their tithes (or head taxes) to the Kings and then they were free to spend the rest of their resources as they desired. Today, here in America, we pay taxes to the IRS and State. Once our taxes are paid, the government does not care how the rest of our money is spent (yet?). They get their portion, we get the rest and generally use it how we want. We are seeing the overreach control of government trying to change this through it claiming ownership.

In Romans 12:1, we're told that we are to present our bodies as living sacrifices, holy, acceptable to Yahweh, which is our reasonable service. Psalm 24 says, 'The earth is the Lord's, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. For He founded it upon the seas...'. Everything we have belongs to Yahweh and is to be used for His purposes, for His agenda...not our own agenda. We see what happened in the parable of the talents to the one who did not use the talent given to him. (Matthew 25:15-29)

The root iniquity of the redemptive gift of Giver is <u>control</u> which brings upon what is known as the Midianite Curse (Judges 6:1-6). The root cause of this curse is:

 You or someone in your bloodline inevitably put comfort or security ahead of fulfilling your stewardship responsibility.

Manifestation of the Midianite Curse in your life or in your future generations is that things or your health or relationships are constantly breaking in a seasonal manner. Things are devoured for no other reason than time. It prevents you from accruing the capital needed to produce change through leverage, not labor. While the needed resources are generally money and relationships, they can include others things.

The essential virtue for the Giver is <u>Faith</u>. We will elaborate more shortly.

The blessing of Job is released when the curse is broken and there is freedom to accumulate resources from year to year so as to obtain enough assets to leverage change. This blessing causes the family and extended relationships to be supernaturally life giving, and it causes one's resources to multiply supernaturally speeding the process of accumulation.

Let's look at Job:

"When I went to the gate of the city and took my seat in the public square, the young men saw me and stepped aside and the old men rose to their feet; the chief men refrained from speaking and covered their mouths with their hands; the voices of the nobles were hushed, and their tongues stuck to the roof of their

mouths. Whoever heard me spoke well of me, and those who saw me commended me, because I rescued the poor who cried for help, and the fatherless a who had none to assist him. The man who was dying blessed me; I made the widow's heart sing. I put on righteousness as my clothing; justice was my robe and my turban. I was eyes to the blind and feet to the lame. I was a father to the needy; I took up the case of the stranger. I broke the fangs of the wicked and snatched the victims from their teeth. "I thought, 'I will die in my own house, my days as numerous as the grains of sand. My roots will reach to the water, and the dew will lie all night on my branches. My glory will remain fresh in me, the bow ever new in my hand."

"Men listened to me expectantly, waiting in silence for my counsel. After I had spoken, they spoke no more; my words fell gently on their ears. They waited for me as for showers and drank in my words as the spring rain. When I smiled at them, they scarcely believed it; the light of my face was precious to them. I chose the way for them and sat as their chief; I dwelt as a king among his troops; I was like one who comforts mourners. (Job 29:7-25 NIV)

Job was a very wealthy and influential man of his time. He is a portrait of a steward. He knew that he had received much from Yahweh and he was doing Yah's work with the resources received from Him. He walked in the principles of design, authority, responsibility, and sowing and reaping. He had obtained high honor and respect among his community.

Stewardship is knowing and accepting that your very life is in Yahweh's hand and He can take it when He wants. Job knew this very well and yet he had the faith to overcome his affliction.

What happened to Job? Yahweh made him prosperous again and gave him twice as much as he had before. Yahweh brought all of Job's relatives and his friends to him after the curse was broken and they each gave him a piece of silver and a gold ring. Though it was not much to start with in regards to investment capital, he was able to rapidly leverage it into great wealth. The Bible says that nowhere in all the land were there found women as beautiful as Job's daughters, and their father granted them an inheritance along with their brothers. After this, Job lived a hundred and forty years; he

saw his children and their children to the fourth generation. He not only walked in the five principles (design, authority, responsibility, sowing & reaping, and stewardship), he also walked in freedom and fulfillment. HOW AWESOME THAT IS!

Ownership produces two (2) undesirable fruits: Arrogance and Fear.

- Arrogance is when one uses the resources for oneself and abandons all of God's principles.
- Fear is when one uses resources carefully, but with the fear that he may loose
 them and not be restored. Not trusting God. By not trusting God, it sets limits to
 the risks they'll take; thus, limiting God's work to be done according to His
 agenda and His purposes.

Now let's look at the essential virtue of Faith to overcome fear and control: Faith and Belief vs. Faith and Presumption. There are three facets of faith:

- 1. Belief,
- 2. Knowledge of God's will, and
- 3. Risk taking

It is easy to believe in something. We believe the sun will rise tomorrow, or that something great is going to happen, or that we are going to be next in line for that promotion, etc. We don't have knowledge of God's will, and where there is no knowledge of God's will, we don't act on faith but on presumption.

Mankind tends to fall in either extreme of playing it safe (ownership) or acting on presumption (arrogance). Many times we find ourselves believing Yahweh for promises that He never made. We act on presumption for whatever reason. When things don't work out, we begin to question our faith and Yahweh. We can always stand on the

Word of Yah, even if He has not promised a specific thing to us personally because His Word does not come back void.

When we take a risk, acting on the guidance of the Holy Spirit, this is faith and belief. We have the knowledge of Yahweh and we are willing to take a risk to accomplish His agenda with His resources. He delights in giving an order to accomplish His agenda. Remember, if Yahweh doesn't tell you to do something, then there is no promise from Him. Yeshua only did what His Father did and only said what His Father said.

There are three facets of a Giver and/or a Giver community where aberrations (deviations/digressions) are evident:

- Fear and Control Manifests as the spirit of Jezebel and Leviathan. Leviathan is a 7-headed spirit of tremendous competence, where they do not need God. (Psalms 74:12-14; Isaiah 27:1; Rev. 17:7-8)
 The spirit of Jezebel is the inability to receive love or reproof from others coupled with a poverty spirit, rooted in fear and woundedness. (Rev. 2:20; 1Kings 16:31 & 21:25, 2Kings 9:22)
- 2. **An Independent Spirit** Can be corrupted into not partnering with other believers for fear of loosing control of the resources God has given them. A hardened heart (Mark 8:17-18), bitterness, living in sin, or hurts can cause this.
- 3. A Religious Spirit Reduces God to a formula i.e. (If you do this, this and this...then God will do this.) This is a form of blasphemy. (Colossians 2 & Galatians, Matthew 15:9)

When Yahweh confronted Job, it is important that you realize that He confronted him on perspective, not on principles (Read Job 40, 41, 42). Job knew the principles of Yah and

used them well; however, Job's perspective of Yahweh was too small. Even when we walk in the principles of Yahweh, if our perspective of who He is and what He can do is not enlarged, we miss wonderful blessings that are waiting for us.

Let's take a look at the negative grid before looking at the positive:

- **-100 Perversion of the blessings.** Brings a curse upon an entire community; dedicating an entire community or nation to Satan.
- **-80 Destruction of social capital.** This is a group of people that have no regard for social capital or for what the previous generation's resources have provided for the future generations. An example would be people partaking in riots; perhaps over racial issues, political issues, or even over a celebration of a sports event (such as what took place at the 2023 NCAA Division 1 Men's Basketball Championship game April 3 & 4, 2023). They are mindless to the destruction of social capital. Another example would be not taking care of our roads, buildings, and parks that previous taxpayers paid for.
- **-60 Theft.** This can range from siphoning off mass amounts of money from an organization to petty theft. Bottom line is there is no stewardship according to Yah's agenda or His purpose. An corporate example would be what happened at ENRON in 2001, FTX Cryptocurrency in 2023, Fluor Corp., Bank Failures, etc. where leadership fooled regulators with fake holdings and off-the-books accounting practices. Bankruptcy followed, people lost money, and leaders went to jail.
- **-40 Exploiter.** These are people using other people for personal gain rather than growing and releasing them for God's purpose and his agenda. Examples range from sexual exploitation to political manipulation by selling personal favors to get elected. This behavior empowers the demonic stronghold over a community/nation.
- **-20 Insularity** (narrow-mindedness). These people basically live a righteous life. They honor the laws of God and land in a general way, but they live for enjoying life and

retiring with ample resources for their own personal agenda. This behavior builds a demonic stronghold over the community. This level represents a vast number of Americans, sadly.

We will now move on to the positive side of the grid.

- **0 Wounded.** At this level, you are walking in obedience for God's agenda rather you're your own personal agenda, but you haven't searched deeper to see where God wants you to be.
- +20 Being Your Brother's Keeper. This level is foundational for the Giver. God asked Cain "where is your brother" and Cain replied, "am I my brother's keeper?" The answer is Yes, you are. Remember the Giver is to use the principles of long-term life changing for future generations.
- **+40 Investing in Family.** At this level, you are investing in your family, while at the same time being your brother's keeper in the community. You invest in the three facets of family? (Financial provisions for caring for body and physical needs; Emotional needs of the family (time, love, nurture); and Spiritual needs of the family (ministering to the spirit, soul and body) Many tend to invest in one or the other, but rarely do we invest in all three. This has mainly been due to a lack of knowledge.
- +60 Embracing the Synergy of the Gifts. You have partnered with other gifted people to release the greatest wealth possible for God's purposes and His agenda. The Giver does not naturally gravitate to other gifts. When willing, it requires synergy. The Prophet and Giver are designed to release maximum wealth. If the two gifts are not synergized, it can be a recipe for great devastation. The occult is an expert in synergizing the gifts and is far bigger than anything the Giver can do alone. The occult is the counterfeit to God's purpose and agenda. The Giver gift needs the input of the

Prophet gift for greatest potential because the light of the Prophet energizes the light of a Giver. The Prophet has earned the authority to release the Giver, and once released, the Giver must not walk in pride.

+80 – Stewarding the Land and Nature. This was the first commandment given to man. Take dominion and subdue the earth. At this level, you understand your role and authority to release from the earth the hidden treasures so they can flow over to the next city and over to the future generations.

This gift is to be used for life. You are using God's resources for His agenda to cleanse the defilement on the land and at the same time are accessing the treasures in the earth for our brothers and sisters around us and for future generations. The occult has a high level of effectiveness that most Christians don't have. They understand the importance of stewardship over the land and nature and they know that western Christianity has rejected this commandment. See Ezekiel 39 and Ezekiel 12 for more revelation. The bible has 1717 scriptures on land and its importance to God.

+100 – Accruing Generational Blessings. This is stewardship in the spiritual arena. You will leave behind generational blessings that will bring transformation. You should be accruing blessings and obeying God. You leverage light in such a way that the blessings come forward. This is a reality. The key is releasing them in the right time of Yahweh and in the right place. They are usually released prior to the death of the patriarch (Genesis 49; 1 Kings 1&2). The timing is important. The release of your generational blessings will carry a maximum impact to your family and your community.
